CFS Music Guidelines

Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the Saints and members of the household of God, having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief Cornerstone, in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit. -Ephesians 2:19-22

The following are guidelines to bear in mind when selecting music for any CFS sanctioned event-dances, sports, graduations, recognitions, etc.

- 1. Does the music give God glory? (1 Corinthians 10:31)
- 2. Can I imagine Christ listening to or dancing along with the music? (1 John 2:6)
- 3. Would I like to be listening to or dancing along with the music when Jesus returns? (1 John 2:28)
- 4. Is the music consistent with a Christian testimony? (1 Thessalonians 5:22)
- 5. Will the music selection cause a weaker brother or sister in faith to stumble? Will it impair his or her growth? (Romans 14:15)

The music selected should avoid inappropriate language, such as swearing or taking God's name in vain and should also avoid inappropriate themes such as, drug use, drinking, sexual undertones, etc.
