

CFS Fine Arts Committee Charter

Purpose

The purpose of the Fine Arts Committee is to

- Create and promote opportunities for students to participate in fine arts (music, speech, visual art, performing art, and debate).
- Identify and develop teachers/leaders to lead fine arts events and opportunities
- Facilitate, recruit and encourage student participation in fine arts opportunities.

Committee Members and Chair

The Committee shall be composed of at least three voting members including at least one member of the Cornerstone Board of Directors. Individuals that serve on the committee in a training role will not be considered voting members.

Additional committee members will be selected by the current acting committee members. A Chairman, secretary, and treasurer will be elected yearly by a majority vote of the committee and will serve for a term of one CFS academic school year.

Length of Term

All members of the committee serve at least a term of one CFS academic school year.

MEETING SCHEDULE

The Committee will meet on an as-needed basis, at least twice per year.

ROLES and RESPONSIBILITIES

The committee is responsible for:

- Supporting fine arts opportunities such as, but not limited to, choir, debate, speech, Bible quiz and visual arts.
- Seeking out and promoting additional opportunities for student participation in fine arts activities.
- Holding a CFS competition as needed to enable students to qualify for regional BAFA competition. The Committee is responsible for notifying the Board and the CFS membership regarding dates, times, requirements, fees, paperwork, qualifications, etc.
- Promulgation and enforcement of CFS rules regarding Fine Arts eligibility and behavior of CFS students.
- Annually reviewing the committee charter
- Maintaining policies specific to Fine Arts, as needed.
